

Using Plant Walks



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Introduction:

Plant Walks is a project completed by Stacy Auld with help from BCIT's open education fund. The project produced fifteen maps in georeferenced PDF form. These maps can be imported into software, such as Avenza Maps, to allow the user to follow self-guided plant tours around the GVRD. This document provides the steps necessary to install Avenza Maps and import the georeferenced PDFs for use.

Importing & Using Maps:

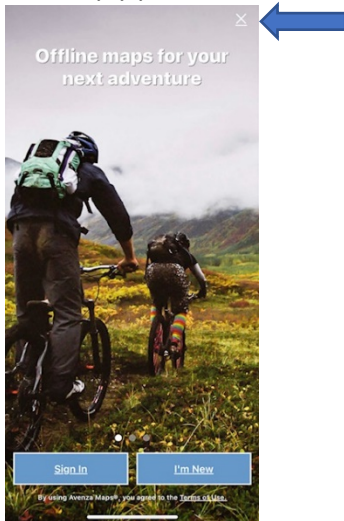
Download Avenza Maps:

[Avenza Maps](#) is an app for iPhone and Android devices available on the [Apple App Store](#) and [Google Play](#).

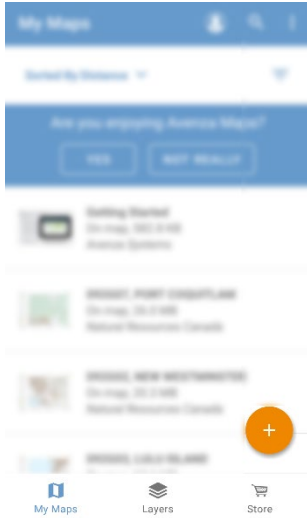
1. Open the Apple App Store (for iPhone) or Google Play (for Android)
2. Search for Avenza Maps
3. Install the app on your device

Import Plant Walks Maps:

1. Launch Avenza Maps on your device, you may be prompted to sign in or create an account, you can simply press the "x" in the top right corner



2. Tap the orange "+" sign in the bottom right corner if you are on Android, or the little "+" in the top right corner if you are on iPhone

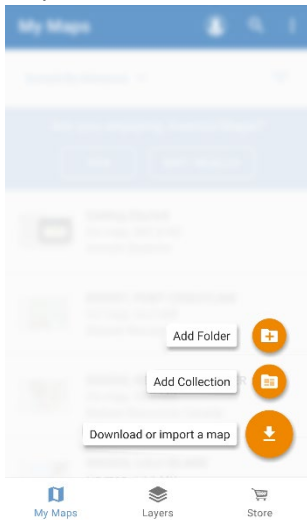

3. If you are on Android, tap “Download or import a map”, if you are on iPhone you can skip this step



4. Tap the QR code symbol in the top right corner to open the QR code scanner



5. Navigate to the QR code for the corresponding map you want to download in this document
6. Scan the QR code with your device
7. Avenza will download and process the map making it ready to use

Using Plant Walks Maps:

1. Physically travel to the corresponding location for the map you would like to use
2. Launch Avenza Maps on your device
3. Select the map for the location you are at
4. Ensure your device's GPS navigation is enabled
5. Use the map to guide yourself to the plants indicated on the map
